We are not a county agency and are not affiliated with any other humane societies. We financially depend on our thrift shop, memberships, donations, adoption fees, grants, and bequests to survive.

Mission Statement

The purpose of the humane society is to provide a safe haven to shelter and care for the abandoned and abused or unwanted animals in Skagit County; to treat the animals with dignity and respect; to place these animals into loving, permanent homes; and to create public education programs that increase the awareness of humane treatment and the necessity of spay and neuter of all animals.

Adoption Fees Varies from the following: (\$30.00 to 155.00)

The adoption fee includes spay or neuter surgery, microchip, collar and HSSV ID tag, first vaccines and free veterinary checkup within Skagit County. for an additional cost of \$6.00 a pet wagon to take pet safely home.

To be considered for adoption today:

If the animal came to us as a stray the animal must be held 72 hours before being available for adoption in accordance with Washington State Law.

You must be 21 years of age to adopt/Fill out this form – We do not accept applications filled out for another person.

Have the consent of your landlord if you rent or lease your home.

Have photo ID and pictures of your present address, when Application is submitted otherwise it is considered incomplete and will not be processed till then.

The Humane Society of Skagit Valley requires that all animals be altered prior to adoption, so as not to contribute to pet overpopulation. This application takes into account such factors as lifestyle, living situation, household activity, location and the individual needs and history or each pet in our care.

The Humane Society of Skagit Valley reserves the right to refuse adoption to anyone. No animal will be adopted to persons having an extensive history of losing, giving away, selling, or having animals injured or killed by moving vehicles or wildlife. No animal will be adopted to prospective owners who mislead or fail to provide accurate information on the adoption application.
