**We are a nonprofit organization providing sheltering and adoption services for abandoned, abused and unwanted pets in Skagit Valley. We provide comfort, daily care and medical services for more than 2900 animals annually who come through our doors. We accept all companion animals from Skagit Valley that need our help. We contract with Skagit County and municipalities to provide sheltering services for animals within their jurisdiction.**


